It opened its doors in 1856 and historically it has been a rather important cultural referent in our province. We have been fortunate to have some illustrious students such as Juan Ramón Jiménez , Literature Nobel Prize winner in 1957, or Antonia Arrobas, the first Spanish woman who studied Secondary Education. Nowadays, IES La Rábida offers Secondary Education, Baccalaureate and Higher Vocational Training for more than 1000 students. Our staff (62 teachers) is</p>	



highly motivated to improve different aspects of their teaching practice. In this sense, we have a growing number of teachers who use CLIL methodology in their classes. Apart from that, we are involved in life-long learning projects dealing with "Skills" and the use of "ICT". Also, we are keen on organising cultural trips, exchange programs and activities related to recycling and sustainability (Recapacicla), preserving our cultural heritage (Sentir el Patrimonio) and in connection with equality, mediation and daily coexistence (Convivencia Plus). Skills are the main focus of the modern Spanish curriculum, therefore we would like to give our students the chance to practice skills and learn about the importance of our local cultural heritage and its European roots outside the normal class.
